2023 Award Categories

The annual Ballarat Senior of the Year Awards acknowledge and celebrate inspirational Ballarat seniors.

Volunteering Award

For exceptional contribution by an individual to their community.

Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Award

For an individual who has contributed significantly to a fairer, more accessible community for all. This person is dedicated to building an inclusive culture that encourages, supports and celebrates our diverse voices. This may include excellence in representing or advocating on behalf of communities such as LGBTIQA+, Disability, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander, Multicultural or other diverse groups, improving community inclusion, or a project that improves social connection and participation.

Healthy and Active Living Award

For an individual for helping to create active and healthy communities through community involvement and as a role model.

Ageing Well Award

For an individual who has worked to combat ageism, promote social justice and engage with their community to support ageing well initiatives.

From these categories, the winner of the overarching **2023 Senior of the Year Award** will be chosen.

2023 BALLARAT SENIOR OF THE YEAR AWARDS NOMINATION FORM

Who is eligible for the Awards?

To be eligible for these Awards, the nominee must be an Australian citizen, a resident of or volunteer in the City of Ballarat local government area and be aged 55 years or over. Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander residents aged 50 years or over are eligible for nomination. Nominees will be assessed on their volunteer contribution and achievements since reaching the qualifying age.

What is the selection criteria?

Nominees will be assessed on:

- How they make a difference to community wellbeing through volunteering
- Their good standing in the community
- How their positive attitude to ageing inspires others.

Step by step guide to making a nomination

- 1. Complete the form, following the instructions carefully
- 2. Keeping in mind the selection criteria above, on two separate pages tell us:
 - a) How has the nominee demonstrated commitment and contribution to the community?
 - b) How is the nominee an inspirational role model?

3. Attach

- a) You must attach at least two letters supporting the nomination from colleagues or individuals in the community.
- b) You can attach copies of up to three pieces of supporting information about your nominee, such as awards and media articles.
