

Concept Notes - Forest Street - Eyre Street
 Angle parking east side b/w Forest + Eyre Street.
 Parallel parking west side including provision for caravan parking.
 Pedestrian access across Warrenheip St (Vicroads approval required).
 New paving throughout.
 Improved drainage and pavement gradients.
 Define key activity/outdoor dining area
 Replacement of Ash trees (east side) and new large form trees west side to form avenue planting.
 Aerial bundling of o/h powerlines
 Provision of grape vines, raised garden bed plantings and ground-cover plantings where appropriate.
 Upgraded bus stop for compliance and amenity.
 Define precinct entry at Eyre Street corner with planting and tree planting
 Consider stone wall entry wall.

Consider relocating ped/crossing to align with east/west movement and to generate additional car space

Paved outstand at post office for crossing, post-office box, pay phone, seating etc. Pedestrian linkage to west side Warrenheip St. Relocate post box and phone both subject to approvals.

Revised bus stop with seating planting and paving for best amenity. Subject to PTV approval.

Trees and planting for streetscape amenity and shade.
