The Housing Strategy will inform our long term plan for housing throughout the municipality and the CBD UDF Framework will inform design outcomes we want to see in future development throughout the CBD.

While separate documents, with different outcomes and objectives, our residential population in the CBD is expected to increase and plays a part in our housing strategy, while the change in the CBD contributes to the liveablity of the whole of Ballarat.

CBD Urban Design Framework our cbd's urban design - <u>Have your say</u>

Our CBD is the heart of Ballarat and as our city grows, the future design direction is crucial to achieving a CBD where people can live, work, shop and meet while respecting and contributing to the liveability and character of Ballarat.

An Urban Design Framework (UDF) will guide future design and development in the CBD to inform what role new development will play and how it will respect and complement our existing CBD, particularly the heritage character of our buildings and the natural landscape of our city.

The UDF identifies principles that underpin good urban design and what standards new development should address in our CBD.

The UDF will inform future Planning Scheme Amendments which will guide future developments in our CBD.

URBAN DESIGN PRINCIPLES:



1. PUBLIC REALM

Footpaths, alleyways, street furniture and open spaces are all part of the public realm. Public realm plays a key role in how we experience and enjoy the Ballarat CBD.

2. BUILDINGS

Future buildings of the CBD provide the opportunity to bring new commercial and residential uses to the CBD while contributing to a design led outcome that improves the streetscape.

3. MOVEMENT

Movement through the Ballarat CBD is critically important to the enjoyment and experience of the area.

4. COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

Community infrastructure promotes sustainable communities and plays an important role in bringing people together.
